Originally introduced by then-Senator Obama, the Act requires

reporting of contracts and grants of over \$25,000 by prime and sub-awardees by this year. Many of you are probably familiar with similar requirements under the American Recovery and Reinvestment Act of 2009.

Organizations must also report all Executive Compensation if they receive more than 80% of their annual gross revenues from Federal awards, and Federal awards are over \$25 million. Ms. Lee clarified during the Q&A that yes, this did apply to Partners at CPA firms!

Recent research has shown that employers attribute their recruiting difficulties to a shortage of qualified professionals.
