April's meeting was held at the Waterview Conference Center on top of the Deloitte building in Rosslyn on Wednesday, April 20<sup>th</sup>. The rain clouds had disappeared, and we had record temperatures in the 80s with beautiful views of the District. We had 43 people pre-registered and 8 walk-ins. The lucky attendees were treated to an open bar as well as appetizers while they socialized.

We were honored to have several **Past NOVAGA Presidents** in attendance, including **Dennis Green** (currently RVP Elect), **John Homan** (Past RVP), and **Mia Leswing** (Past RVP & National Treasurer Elect). Also in attendance were **President Elect Kristy Green** and **President Elect Designate Heather Keister**. We also had several members of the AGA Regional team in attendance – **Karl Boettcher** (Senior VP at large) and **Flora Milans** (RVP).

Our featured speaker was **Doug Criscitello, HUD CFO**, who is certainly well-qualified for the position. Doug worked at OMB in the early 90s during fiscally responsible times that saw the Budget Summit at Andrews AFB, the CFO Act, and the Credit Reform Act. From there he went to start the Independent Budget Office of New York City – where he made great strides in bringing transparency to the City's government. In fact, in 1997, he set up an interactive Web site program to show taxpayers where their local, State, and Federal taxes went – a transparency that President Obama promised to the country in his State of the Union address and which debuted recently on [www.whitehouse.gov](http://www.whitehouse.gov) – I tested it out and it's very enlightening! Try it yourself and see! Foreign Aid is a much smaller chunk of our bill as you might think listening to the cable TV anchors (see box with percentages on next page).

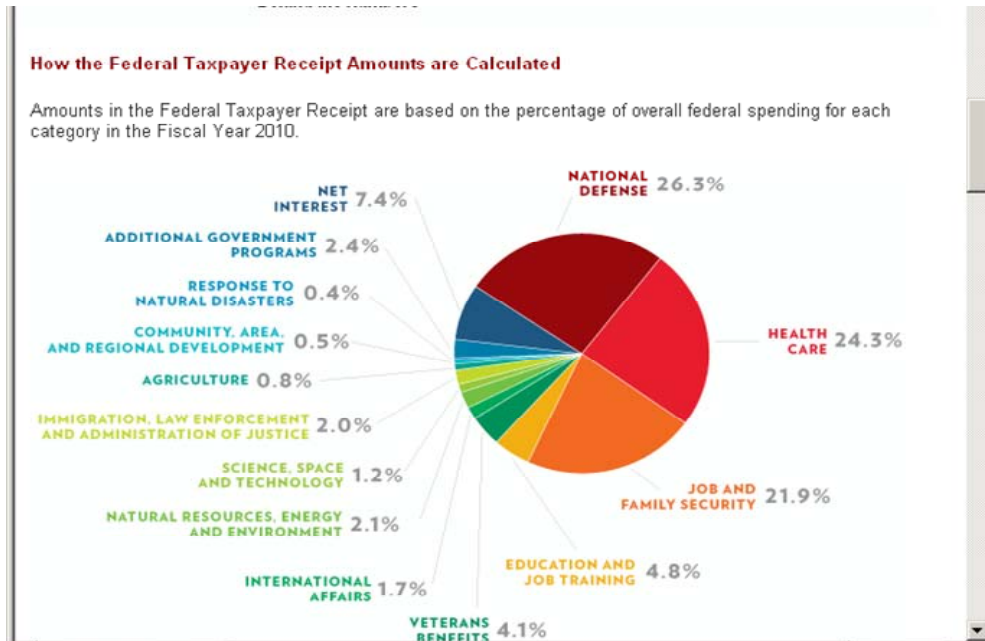
Doug commented that the current Federal CFOs want to do more than just crunch the numbers, they have a strategic vision – in fact, the CFO and IG community has been asked by Congress for ways to improve the CFO Act after 20 years, and he is writing a section on the Financial Reporting Model – what is really the best way to present the US Government's finances? Because we don't just want to show where we've been, but we want to look forward.

### **Our Mission**

We are a community-based non-profit that provides supplemental groceries to our Arlington neighbors in need.

### **Our Vision**

We are the community leader in providing and promoting dignified access to nutritious food for all Arlingtonians in need.

Now over 20 years after its founding, the Arlington Food Assistance Center remains dedicated to its simple but critical mission of obtaining and distributing groceries, directly and free of charge, to people living in Arlington who cannot afford to purchase enough food to meet their basic needs.

While hunger might not seem to be an issue in a wealthy county like Arlington, the high cost of living here, combined with our current economic situation, means that many families struggle to make ends meet. Supplemental groceries from AFAC mean that families can remain in their homes, workers can stay on the job, children are ready to learn, and mothers and babies have the nutrition they need. We help relieve the food budgets of our clients, thereby allowing them to make other necessary purchases without sacrificing their health and nutrition needs.

Families need a referral to get food from AFAC. Referrals can come from an Arlington County government agency or one of many local churches, schools or social service agencies.

AFAC serves as an effective partner in Arlington's comprehensive social service delivery system. If local social workers identify a need for food with their clients, they can easily make a referral to us. This system ensures that our clients are legitimate, and that all their needs are being assessed and addressed.

AFAC operates under the Choice Model. This means that we try to provide as much choice as possible in the foods that a family can take away from AFAC. The Choice Model has been proven to reduce waste, as families are more likely to eat foods they choose to take home. We provide different kinds of meats, breads, and canned goods. We allow choice between 1% milk and 2% milk. We offer a variety of baked goods for families. When produce is available, families are often able to choose between 2 or 3 types. In addition, we are seriously committed to distributing as much nutritious food as possible. We buy meats, milk, eggs and other fresh items, so that families, especially mothers and babies, can get the nutrition they need.

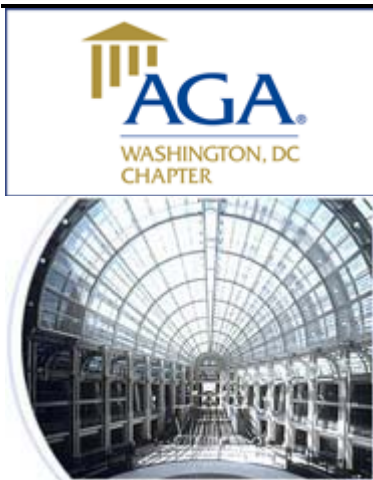
